

This version of Town of Friday Harbor's ordinance is partial, concerning only portions pertaining to the cross connection policy, the entire ordinance concerning customers rules and regulations which govern water use and service can be obtained from the Town of Friday Harbor Water Department. The partial ordinance reads as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 950

(Sections pertaining to cross-control connection)

AN ORDINANCE by the Town of Friday Harbor concerning the protection of the municipal water supply from contamination or pollution from cross connections, and amending Ordinance #616 and Friday Harbor Municipal Code Chapter 13.04, and repealing Ordinance 675 in its entirety.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Friday Harbor:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. That the purpose of this ordinance is to protect the public health of the water consumer of the Town of Friday Harbor municipal water system by the control of actual of potential cross connections. It shall be the responsibility of the Town of Friday Harbor to protect the public drinking water system from contamination due to cross connection. The owner of the property in which a cross connection occurs is fully responsible for all damages incurred.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Ordinance #616 and Friday Harbor Municipal Code 13.04.020 are hereby deleted and changed to read as follows:

13.04.020 Definitions. As used in this division:

- D. "Cross Connection" – Any physical arrangement whereby a public water supply is connected, directly or indirectly, with a source of water not approved for the system, or any non-potable supply, which may be capable of contaminating the public drinking system as a result of backflow.
- J. "Public Drinking Water System" – Any water system or supply intended or used for human consumption or other domestic uses; including source, treatment, storage, transmission, and distribution facilities where water is furnished to any community, collection, or number of individuals; however excluding a system serving one (1) single family residence.
- N. "Town Water Supply System" The water resources, storage tanks, distribution lines, fire hydrants, meters, pumps, and all other appurtenances necessary for the supply of domestic water.

SECTION 3. Section 3 (f) of Ordinance #616 and Friday Harbor Municipal Code 13.04.020 are hereby y deleted and changed to read as follows:

"14.04.080 System requirements"

- B. No person with a property or building connected to the town water system shall alter or extend the piping of his property or building in such a manner as to meet the test of multi-use, if intended water use was for only one unit, or change the class of use other than the class applied for. Any such alteration or extension shall justify immediate disconnection from the town water system.
- C. No person supplied with water from the town water system shall use it for any purpose other than that stated in the application, and/or for which the person pays water rates.
- D. No person shall install or maintain any actual or potential cross connection to the public drinking water system. Any such cross connection now existing is hereby declared unlawful and shall be removed immediately.

- E. The control or elimination of cross connection shall be in accordance with the State of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 248-54-285), or any superseding WAC.
- F. Water services to any premise shall be contingent upon the customer providing cross connection control in a manner approved by the purveyor.
- G. The policies, procedures, and criteria for determining appropriate levels of protection shall be in accordance with the “Accepted Procedure and Practice in Cross Connection Control Manual – Pacific Northwest Section – American Waterworks Association, Fourth Edition”, or any superseding editions, however, the town council may establish requirements for cross connection control more stringent than the state regulation if it is determined that the conditions so dictate.
- H. Backflow prevention assemblies, if required, shall:
 - 1. be a model approved by the department,
 - 2. be installed under the direction of the water supervisor and/or under the supervision of a cross connection specialist,
 - 3. be tested at least annually at the owner’s expense. Completed test reports shall be returned to the Town of Friday Harbor within 30 days after receipt of the yearly test notification. Tests and inspections may be required on a more frequent basis at the discretion of the water supervisor. Authorized employees of the Town of Friday Harbor with proper identification shall have free access at reasonable hours of the day to all parts of premises or within buildings to which water is supplied. Water service shall be refused or terminated to any premise for failure to allow necessary inspections.

SECTION 4. Section 3(g) of Ordinance #616 and Friday Harbor Municipal Code 13.04.090 are hereby deleted and changed to read as follows:

13.04.90 Prohibited acts. The following acts are prohibited:

- C. To install or maintain any actual or potential cross connection.
- G. To reconnect pipes that have been disconnected, to turn water on or off without written permission from the water supervisor or town clerk when the water has been turned off for failure to pay water, sewer, or refuse bills.

SECTION 5. Section 12 of Ordinance # 616 and Friday Harbor Municipal Code 13.04.150 are hereby deleted and changed to read as follows:

- A. Water service to any premise receiving its water from the purveyor’s public drinking water system shall be contingent upon compliance with all rules and regulations of the department and the purveyor. Service shall be discontinued to any premise for failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the department and the purveyor.
- B. A violation of any section of this chapter shall be deemed a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Each day a violation continues shall be considered a separate violation.
