Who is eligible to sign up for the Town recycling program?

Presently, the Town recycling program is available to Single-Family Residential homes. The Town plans to develop a Multi-Family Residential recycling program in the near future.

How do I sign up for recycling service, how much does it cost, and what is the schedule?

- You may sign up in writing at Town Hall or send your request to: billing@fridayharbor.org
- It costs \$2.00 for each 32-gallon container collected.
- Recycling is collected the first and third week of each month on your regularly scheduled garbage day.

What are the rules for recycling?

- Recycling must be in a 32-gallon, weatherproof container with a lid.
- Containers must be labeled with a “Recycle” sticker and your house number. For your convenience, we can provide you with the appropriate labels.
- **ANY items that are not properly rinsed or recyclable will not be collected.**

Due to recent changes in how our recycling is transported, please pay special attention to the recycling rules below.

Thank you for adhering to these rules to help maintain the success of our community recycling program.

What items are recyclable?

- Cardboard (packaging, pizza/frozen food boxes, etc.) & paper grocery bags
- Egg cartons & paper cups (free of residue)
- Magazines, books, catalogs, newspapers, phonebooks, etc.
- Mail (window envelopes, store ads, etc.)
- RINSED Plastic jars, bottles, jugs, yogurt cups, sour cream containers, etc.
- RINSED Glass bottles and jars (any color)
- Jar/container labels and lids OK if attached.
- RINSED Aluminum, steel, or tin cans
- RINSED Milk cartons and juice boxes
- RINSED Aluminum foil and trays
- Computer/office paper
- Shredded paper (in clear plastic bag ONLY)
- Garden nursery pots & flats
- EMPTY aerosol cans

What items are NOT recyclable?

- ANY food-soiled paper products or containers
- Plastic dome lids or straws
- Prescription vials
- Styrofoam packaging, packing peanuts, etc.
- Paint or paint cans, gas cans, or tanks
- Propane bottles
- Light bulbs (of any type)
- Ceramics or dishes
- Toxic containers (oils, antifreeze, pesticides, herbicides, etc.)
- Needles or syringes (i.e. “sharps”)
- Mirrors or window glass
- Disposable diapers, rags, or clothing
- Soil or food compost
- Bubble, shrink, or food wrap
- Wood, rubber, concrete, or other construction materials
