Blair Street Mural Proposal

Board members observed and discussed a mock-up of the mural proposed to go on the wall on Blair Street between the old Presbyterian Church building and Tia's Tacos. The mural consists of a grouping of paintings documenting Island agriculture.

It was unclear whether an applicant was coming to the meeting. Board member David Harsh called the proposal's artist, Annie Howell-Adams. Ms. Howell-Adams indicated that she would be happy to come at a future time to discuss the work. Board member Harsh inquired as to the materials planned for her proposed paintings. Howell-Adams explained that they would be painted separately on aluminum panels with non-fade paint then clear coated and that they would be like her series of paintings in Peace Health Hospital.

After some discussion it was agreed that ideally it would be best to have both the artist Annie Howell-Adams and Farhad Ghatan present for a review of the project.
